International guidance published on older people with diabetes and frailty

International guidelines outlining a ground-breaking model for how to manage older people with physical weakness and fatigue who have diabetes has been published.

An International Position Statement on the Management of Frailty in Diabetes Mellitus was led by Professor Alan Sinclair of the Foundation for Diabetes Research in Older People at Diabetes Frail (UK).

The document makes a series of recommendations to help doctors and nurses treat the over 70s who have diabetes and who may also suffer from conditions linked to physical weakness.
